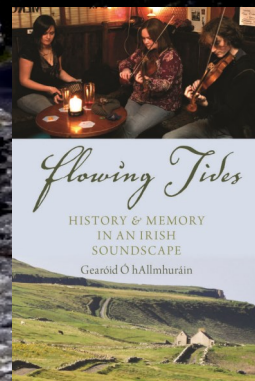

ITINERARY HIGHLIGHTS: **Incl. daily historic expertise from Professor Gearóid Ó hAllmhuráin and nightly music recitals and sessions.*

Day 01, Shannon - Dingle - Killarney. Morning arrival at Shannon Airport. We travel south to the Dingle Peninsula in County Kerry. From Sleah Head, we will see the Blasket Islands, the last outpost in Europe. Visit the Blasket Centre, the 1200 year old Gallarus Oratory and monastic beehive huts. Overnight: Killarney (dinner included).

Day 02, Killarney - Ring of Kerry. Depart today for the Ring of Kerry, one of Ireland's most popular and beautiful drives. Along the Iveragh Peninsula, spectacular wind-swept cliffs, lakes, valleys and rocky mountains blend in awesome majesty. We visit the 19th century Muckross House & Gardens and Mucros Weavers craft workshop. Overnight Killarney (dinner included).

Day 03, Killarney - Bunratty - Ennis. We leave Killarney north to Clare and journey back to Celtic times and life in the Bronze Age settlement of Cragganowen. We'll check into our Ennis hotel after a quiet walk amid the ruins of Quin Abbey. Refreshed, we'll explore the 'living' village in Bunratty Folk Park, before attending a medieval banquet at the 15th century Bunratty Castle. Overnight in Ennis.

Day 04, Ennis - Inner Burren. Today we explore the lunar landscape of the Burren and visit the 15th century Dysert O'Dea Castle and iconic portal tomb at Poulabrone, which dates to Neolithic times. We will visit the Burren Museum in Kilfenora, home of the famous Irish céili band and Caherconnell ringfort. Overnight in Ennis -dinner on your own.

Day 05, Ennis - Achill Island - Westport. Today we head north to Mayo, birthplace of Granuaile, Ireland's 16th century Pirate Queen. A quick stop in the coastal village of Mulranny, enroute to Achill Island for a day of exploration. Overnight in Westport (dinner included).

Day 06, Westport - Connemara National Park - Clifden. Departing Westport, we'll visit the National Famine Monument, and perhaps join pilgrims climbing Croagh Patrick, Ireland's sacred mountain. We'll travel through the breathtaking Maam Valley and Connemara National Park, via Leenane and Killary fjord (photo stop at Kylemore Abbey) and finish our day in a castle hotel in picturesque Clifden overlooking the Atlantic (dinner included).

Day 07, Clifden - Galway. Leaving North Connemara for Galway City, 'City of the Tribes' and European Capital of Culture, our day includes a boat cruise on Lough Corrib and walking tour. Free night to discover the city's rich artistic offerings.

Day 08, Galway - Aran Islands - Galway. We depart for the port of Ros a' Mhíl and ferry to Inis Mór, largest of the Aran islands to visit the cliff-edge stone fort of Dún Aonghasa. We return to our Galway hotel for dinner on your own, and perhaps a visit to Claddagh Village.

Day 09, Galway - Coastal Burren Route - Spanish Point. Leaving Galway, we follow the spectacular Burren coastline to the village of Doolin and towering Cliffs of Moher, 700ft above the roaring Atlantic, and meander its coastal walking paths. Our final evening is spent in Spanish Point, named for shipwrecks of the Spanish Armada. After dinner on own, we meet for a final farewell with master Irish traditional musicians.

Day 10, Shannon - U.S. Early morning transfer to Shannon Airport for your return flight home. Flights to the U.S. arrive home the same day.
